What is NYLT?

NYLT is a week-long course that gives Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Venturers, and Sea Scouts the methods, skills, and experiences to become better leaders in their unit. The course centers around the concepts of what a leader must be, what he/she must know, and what he/she must do – with a clear focus on how to accomplish all this. Enrollment in NYLT courses is limited, so sign-up soon.

What are the pre-requirements?

Participants must hold or intend to hold a unit leadership position to be eligible for the course, and satisfy the following requirements: Boy Scouts or Varsity Scouts must be at least 13 years old and First Class rank or higher by the first day of the course but not 18 by the end of the course. Venturers (male or female) must be at least 14 years old and registered in a Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship but not 21 by the end of the course. Ideal candidates for this course are Scouts and Venturers who are comfortable spending a week camping with no contact with their families for an in-depth leadership experience. Each participant must attend the course in its entirety and may not arrive late or leave early. If the participant is asked to leave camp early, no refund will be granted.
